Raise awareness, reduce stigma and foster inclusion through campaigns.
- 🕒 **Develop support**
Design psychological and legal frameworks plus training materials.
- 🕒 **Engage authorities**
Strengthen cooperation with law enforcement and public agencies.
- 🕒 **Monitoring & evaluation**
Collect data, track progress and report on outcomes.
